

USER INSTRUCTIONS IMMUNOCHEMICAL FECAL OCCULT BLOOD TEST (FIT test)

SAMPLING METHOD

Your doctor has prescribed an immunochemical test for occult blood (blood that is not visible to the naked eye) in your stools. It is a simple test used to screen for colorectal cancer.

To do the test you will be given:

- a tube-shaped container
- a plastic bag

You may have received:

- · a waterproof, biodegradable paper
- If not, use a disposable container (not provided).

TO ENSURE ACCURATE TEST RESULTS, IT IS IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS


ATTENTION: If you are having your period or have bleeding hemorrhoids, wait until the bleeding stops before collecting your specimen.

Open your sample collection kit.





Turn and pull the green cap to open the sample collection tube.



Lightly scratch the surface of the stools with the green stem attached to the cap. A small sample of your stool is sufficient to cover the end of the stem. Reinsert the stem into the tube and close it tightly. Do not reopen the tube once you have closed it.



Unfold the paper. Place it directly on the clean water in the center of the toilet bowl so With paper: that the sides of the paper stick to the wall of the bowl.

> You can use a plastic container or an aluminum plate which you will throw after collecting the sample.




You may then flush the toilet.



Wash your hands.



Put your sample tube in the plastic bag and close it.

Let your stools fall onto the paper (the container). Your stools should not be mixed with urine or any other liquid before sampling.

CONSERVATION AND STORAGE

a) When done, keep your sample in the refrigerator;

b) Bring your stool sample along with the analysis request form (doctor's prescription) at room temperature no later than 48 hours following the sample at the reception of the hospital laboratory Hôpital Honoré-Mercier or at one of the CLSCs in our region, whose telephone contact details and website (CLSC) can be found below:
